The abstract volume is limited to 200 words, Times New Roman 12 pt font, single line spacing. Please avoid figures and complicated equations, whenever possible. MS Word DOC or RTF files are accepted.

The registration form should include the following information:

1. Principal author (full name, age – for participation in the best paper award for young scientists and students).
2. Preferred section.
3. Preferred form of presentation (oral or poster).
4. Mailing address, telephone with the city code, e-mail.
5. Accommodation information.
